After the devastation brought about by typhoons “Ondoy” and “Pepeng”, Mapúa has been receiving a lot of requests for Leave of Absence, Payment Reconstruction and Promissory Notes from its students. As such, Mapúa is planning to set up a program for students greatly affected by the calamity. The program will be called **“Financial Assistance for Mapúan Typhoon Victims” (FAMTV)**.

With our desire to widen our reach to affected Mapúa students, we would like to **solicit your help through cash donations, regardless of the amount**, which amount will immediately become part of the FAMTV Fund.

The FAMTV fund will help recipients through **assistance in the payment of their tuition fees for one (1) to a maximum of two (2) Quarters** (covering October 2009 - March 2010) depending on their need. **Mapúa will extend counterpart forty percent (40%) tuition fee discount** for every approved grantee/recipient to match the funds solicited from generous alumni, companies, individuals and institutions.

Grantees of the FAMTV will be required to submit documentation and will be interviewed and evaluated by the Committee currently evaluating the recipients of Mapúa’s tuition fee discount programs for financially challenged, and in accordance with the said Committee’s existing guidelines.
